

Applying the Chinese Government Scholarship of Chang' an University

INTRODUCTION OF CHINESE GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS

In order to promote the mutual understanding, cooperation and exchanges in various fields between China and other countries, the Chinese government has set up a series of scholarship programs to sponsor international students, teachers and scholars to study and conduct research in Chinese universities.

INSTRUCTION LANGUAGE

(1) Undergraduate scholarship recipients register for Chinese-taught and English-taught credit courses. They are required to take one-year preparatory courses in one of the 10 universities listed below and to pass the required test before moving on to their major studies.

Undergraduate scholarship recipients can apply for preparatory course exemption if they completed their secondary education in Chinese or have a valid HSK certificate that meets the requirements of the host university. Official documents from secondary schools or a photocopy of a valid HSK certificate must be submitted for a preparatory course exemption application. Please NOTE that HSK results are valid for only 2 years.

(2) Graduate and non-degree scholarship students can register for either the Chinese-taught program or the English-taught program if applicable.

Scholarship recipients of Chinese-taught programs without adequate Chinese proficiency must take Chinese language courses for one to two academic years to reach the language requirements of their host universities before moving on to their major studies. Failure to reach the required language proficiency will lead to the automatic termination of scholarship.

Scholarship recipients of the English-taught programs or those with adequate Chinese language proficiency do not need to take Chinese language courses.

FULL SCHOLARSHIP COVERS

Tuition waiver. Tuition funds will be comprehensively used by the host university. It may cover scholarship students' education, administration costs and expenditures to support student activities.

ACCOMMODATION:

Undergraduate students (preppies), master's students (general scholars): CNY 700 per month; doctoral students (senior scholars): CNY 1000 per month.

STIPEND:

Undergraduate students: CNY 2,500 per month;

Master's students/general scholars: CNY 3,000 per month; Doctoral students/senior scholars: CNY 3,500 per month.

Within the scholarship duration, registered scholarship students will receive a stipend from their host university each month. Students registering on or before the 15th of the month will receive a full stipend of that month. Those who register after the 15th of the month will receive a half stipend of that month. Graduating students will receive stipend until half month after the graduation date. If registered student stays out of China for more than 15 days due to a personal reason (school holidays excluded), his stipend will be stopped during his leaving.

INTRODUCTION OF CHANG' AN UNIVERSITY

Directly under the administration of Ministry of Education, Changan University is one of the State "211 Project" key development universities, and the advantage subject innovation platform construction university of national "985 project". Chang' an University has 21 colleges and departments. There are 7 post–doctoral research stations, 58 doctoral, 142 master and 79 undergraduate specialties.

HOW TO APPLY:

Chinese government scholarships

According to the related notifications, foreign students, who want to study in our university, can apply the Chinese Government Scholarship from the middle of December.

Details are as following:

- 1. Courses and Programs: all the majors for master and PhD degree of Chang' an University.
 - 2. Admissions Categories: full–time graduate students and doctoral students.
 - 3. Teaching Language: Chinese or English (depends on different majors).
 - 4. Application Process:
- A. The applicants login the CSC (China Scholarship Council) Online Application System for International Students (http://www.csc.edu.cn/studyinchina or www.campuschina.org) for online application.
 - B. The code of Chang' an University for online registration is 10710.
 - C. Choose: Program Category-B
- D. Please send the following materials before the end of march in next year (every documents two copies):
 - 1) Scholarship Application Form (generated by the online registration);
- 2) Copies of the last notarized Academic Certification, Graduation Certification or Diploma, as well as the English translation ones;
 - 3) Copy of Transcripts;
 - 4) Study Plan:
 - 5) Letter of Recommendation(two);
 - 6) Copies of Physical Examination Record for Foreigners and Blood Test Report.

Please note: The applicants should take the original documents mentioned above when you are admitted by our university and come to China.
